

Secure and Maintain Administrative Support



Administrative support is essential to seeing substantial and sustainable change through WSCC implementation. Administrators can demonstrate their commitment by ensuring staff has support and resources to implement WSCC plans and by acting as champions in overall promotion and engagement.



The Administrator Role

The WSCC Administrator must have some knowledge of WSCC and the implementation process. Planning and allocating resources should start prior to the beginning of the implementation year. To demonstrate their commitment to WSCC, the Administrator should drive efforts to stay engaged throughout the process.

What do WSCC Administrators do?



Identify and appoint a qualified school health coordinator.



Drive effort to incorporate WSCC model in school mission, vision, policies and goals.



Serve as a champion and advocate for wellness events.



Set up a team budget aligned with the school budget.



Initiate completion of WSCC-related assessments and action plans.



Prioritize WSCC professional development opportunities.
